Jewish Day is Sunset to Sunset. Gregorian Calendar made a change to the Julian

Within these tables, January 1 is always the first day of the year.

The Gregorian calendar did not exist before October 15, 1582. Gregorian dates before that are *proleptic*, that is, using the Gregorian rules to recon backward from October 15, 1582. Augustus corrected errors in the observance of leap years by omitting leap days until A.D. 8. Julian calendar dates before A.D. 8 are proleptic, and do not necessarily match the dates actually observed in the Roman Empire.

Fri Oct 5, 1582 10 days later it was Fri Oct 15, 1582. What happen to 3 days in the calendar (Friday to Friday should be 7 days).
